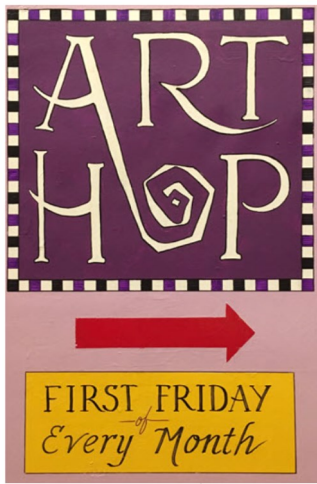

This is a reminder that when you bring work into the gallery for a new show you need to do the following:

Schedule the last weekend of every month as a reminder to pick up and deliver so you never miss displaying your work in the gallery. Don't wait for a reminder.

- **Label your work.**

- If it is hanging art, you should clearly put a label on the back with your name, the title of the art, the media and the price. Do NOT use post it notes, they fall off and get lost.
- If it is not a hanging piece, you should price each individual piece, with your name or number and price. Stickers are ok but we need to be able to clearly identify the piece. If you don't need a printed label for each piece, you do not need to list each individual item, but you should log them; i.e. 4 cups at \$20, etc. We will try to create individual labels for each item if they are listed individually. This includes cards and prints.

- **Place incoming artwork in the bins in the back room.**

- We don't really want to stack it up in the front of The Gallery. The gallery hanging team is challenged when incoming art is spread around the gallery.
- If you have special hanging instructions, for example if you want the items hung for two months or are not going to be able to pick up your work at the end of the month let Elsa Bates know tenorherb@aol.com. It's best to go directly to The Gallery team.

- **Deliver your work on time.**

Our receiving for gallery shows is almost always the last weekend of the month and we hang the show the following Monday or Tuesday. Labels are created right away. It is difficult to find places for work that is delivered after the show has been hung and creates extra work for the volunteer who is creating the labels.

- **Bring your calendar, Sign up to sit The Gallery and Pay Your hanging fees.**

If you can't sit The Gallery please arrange for another member to fill in. We have a couple of members who will sit The Gallery for \$20. It is possible to make special arrangements if you can't sit one month but maybe can twice the next month. We also will waive hanging fees for people who sign up and sit 3 times a month. Work with us. It's important to have The Gallery open on our regular days.

Lodi Art Foundation maintains a list of artists that would like to show their work at the Art Hop venues around town. We are starting the next 4 months of Art Hop Venues in August. There are some new places that have signed up. Some of these venues are would like to feature art in action, so if you can do plein air or some other art activity during the art hop that venue is for you. If you would like to have your name on the list of available artists please let us know. What we need is your name, email, phone and type of art you do. The art center does not act as a go between or schedule you to show, it is strictly an agreement between you and the venue owner. Some venues let you hang and sell your work all month, some take a commission on sales, and some do not. You do not need to be a member of the Lodi Art Center to show your work at any of the other venues in the Art Hop. Contact lo-diartcenter@gmail.com if you would like your name added to the list.

Tips for Showing Your Work at Art Hop

- Check out the venue before you agree to show your work.
- Make sure that there is enough space to show your work.
- Find out what the vendor requires in return.
- Ask when you set up and take down your work.
- Ask if you can sell your work.
- Do they handle sales?
- Do they take a commission?
- Do you need to provide food or drink for the reception?
- Make sure you have an agreement with the vendor (preferably in writing) on what is expected.
- Make sure that they know what kind of work you do, i.e. if you only do sculptures do they have a space to display, if you do primarily hanging pieces do they have adequate space to hang your work.
- Have business cards for people to pick up.
- Have a bio on display so people can find out more about you when you are busy talking others.
- Try to talk to everyone that stops by.
- Be on time, don't leave before the Art Hop is over.
- Be sure to use your own social networking and email lists to let people that know you and your work that you will be showing at the venue. After all the venue is hoping to get new customers in their shop by hosting an artist.

Being an Art Hop artist is fun and can bring you some additional sales. I hope many of you will sign up.
