Linda Nunes will be at the art Center teaching her Encaustic 101 class. More details to come.

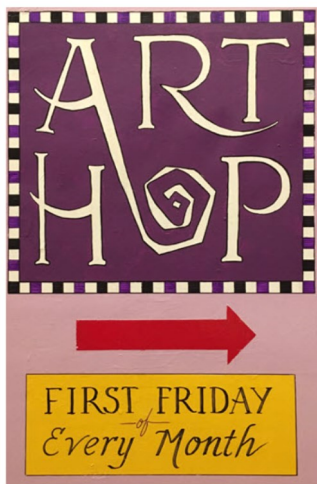
Exploring Media and Materials with Caroline Henry

I hope you enjoy your time at the gallery. Please welcome visitors, ask if they are first time visitors, and if they are, tell them that we are a local non-profit promoting local art and artists. You might share information about the First Friday Art Hops. Don't hesitate to tell visitors about other galleries in Lodi—we want them to think of this as an "art town". If you share information about your own art or other artists in the gallery, you help gallery visitors make a connection with our art.

If things are quiet, how can you use your time? Become familiar with where things are, look at the art in the gallery, check out the bro-

chures and postcards so you can answer questions that may come up, see which members have business cards here—you will know those artists are happy to be contacted by interested art lovers, clean or neaten areas that need it, work on your own art, or bring another favorite activity with you. We have several class sign up lists on the wall and flyers on the side table. Be aware of them.

We are starting a new fiscal / membership year for the gallery this month. I am excited about the upcoming Membership Show. I don't know about the rest of you but I have some great art to enter in this show that did not make it in the Spring Show. I think it will be a great show. I hope you have your art ready to bring in on June 24th and 25th. I know we need some extra hands to help with receiving on those days and also on Monday the 26th for judging. Tina Moore is our judge, I think she will do a great job. Tina will also be at the gallery on **July 11th at 6:30 to** do a Judge's Critique. These critiques are always interesting and answer the question we all have "What was she thinking?" I hope we will have a big turnout for this event. July is the time to renew your membership, so I hope all of you will do so, our goal is to have 50 new or renewing members by the end of July with an annual goal of having 100 members by this time next year. The board voted to give every new or renewing member this year a card that allows you 1 free \$5 hanging fee. If you have already renewed or joined we will put your card in the mail soon. The free hanging fee card can't be used for any juried shows. We would like to see more art every month in the gallery. This is just our way of saying thank you for your continuing support.

The Board also voted on other changes to the gallery fees. After this year's Membership Show we will start charging 30% commission on all artist sales. Hanging fees for 2d art over \$75 will remain the same \$5 apiece. 2D art that hangs or is displayed on easels is \$5 for up to 5. Jewelry, pottery, glass, and other 3D art will have the most changes in fees. We will rent space by the foot. A four foot shelf will be \$10 a month regardless of the price of the items. 2ft will be \$5 a month. We will accept cards in the common racks at \$5 per month. Unframed originals or prints are \$5 for up to 5. If you bring in your own large card rack it will be \$10 per month. We will waive fees for cards in the miscellaneous card racks or unframed art if you show 2 or more hanging items in the gallery. We realize that these changes may mean you need to raise your prices slightly or rethink how you display but to be honest the gallery needs to bring in more money to remain in its current location. Our rent is going to be raised again in January, we are operating at a loss and do not have the reserve funds to continue to do so.

We continue to need to raise funds for the gallery to be able continue to operate. In recent months we have received donations to boost our advertising budget with ads in the San Joaquin Magazine. We have also had two Art Center angels stepping forward and donating significant funds to the gallery. Thank you Glenda McBride and Bob Hathaway: you breathe new life in the gallery and give me hope for the future. If you would like to help the gallery in a significant way or know someone that would please contact and member of the Board.

Membership Chairman

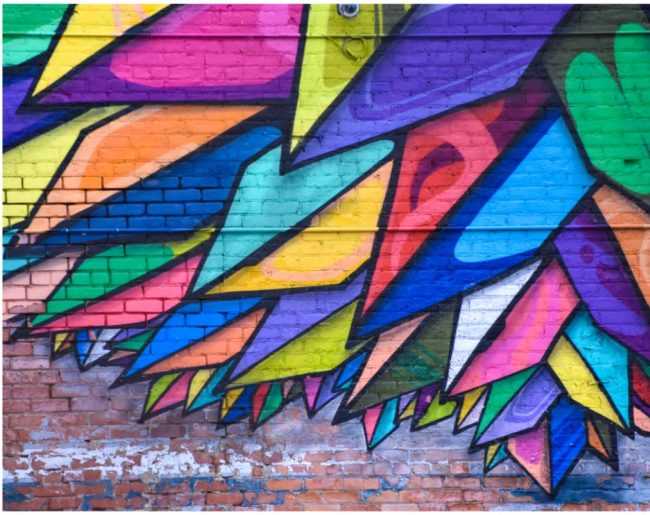

We also need more kids classes, painting, mixed media and STEAM classes that mix art and science. We need a Chairman to organize and schedule classes. We also need artists who are interested in teaching classes in the studio. If you are interested in teaching a class please let JC Strote know and we will set a schedule and promote the class.
