## Recent Board Actions

Over the last two months the board has passed a number of measures.

- **Election of Darrell O'Sullivan as interim Vice President**
- **Approved new program called Art to Business Partnership.** This program will solicit donations from local businesses of \$250 per year. In return the gallery will member art work 4-6 per business in offices and public locations; rotating the work every quarter. Work will be sold by the gallery at same commission as if sold in the gallery. Artists who regularly show in the gallery would be able to participate in program at no cost. Artists who do not show in the gallery can participate for quarterly fee of \$25. Artist fee will be waived if the artist agrees to sit in gallery once a month or if the artist signs up a vendor. Program will begin marketing in November and begin hanging work in January.
- **Gallery shows will begin rotating work every 2 months versus monthly.** Featured artist show will be for one month only. Fees remain the same i.e. cost per hanging piece is \$5 per month, cost for jewelry, table pieces is \$5 per month. This is a trial program for 6 months starting in January. Same requirement; you need to sit the gallery once each month. Fees will be waived if you sit more than 3 times a month.

- **Board voted to implement a raffle for participating gallery artists.** Artists showing in the gallery will get one raffle ticket for each \$5 hanging fee paid. First artist raffle will be for the November show. Raffle will be items donated to the gallery, gift cards, free hanging fees. Just a small thank you for participating in the gallery. November prize is wooden nickels from Double Dip Gallery.
- **Gallery will participate in the Festival of Trees at Mickey Grove Park.** Festival of Trees is the weekend of December 3 -4. Ornaments created will be sold in the gallery as a fund raiser after the Festival of Trees. JC Strote donated ceramic tiles to be decorated by members. You can pick a couple of tiles at the gallery. All tiles need to be returned to the gallery by November 20.
- **We would like to have a holiday boutique Saturday November 26** (Small business Saturday), tables will be set up in the gallery and Studio. We need a chairman for this event. If no chairman is available we will not hold it.



## **Presidents Message**

It's been both an encouraging and discouraging month for me as president. October we are displaying another great photography show in the gallery. Participation was down for this show but it looks like we will still make \$1,000 in revenue for the show but the quality of work was up. The juror, Steward Schultz, for this show was great. His critique of the show on the 11<sup>th</sup> was one of the best critique's I've attended at the gallery. Turn out for the critique was discouraging only 3 of the participating photographers attended. I would really like to know how we can have more people attend our free demonstrations. We have a grant of \$1500 to bring in high quality speakers but only a very few people attend. Next month on November 8th Jun-Adjing Jamosmos, acrylic artist is our demo artist.

I am happy to announce that Darrell O'Sullivan has agreed to fill out the interim term of Vice President. It is will sadness that I accepted the resignations of Becky Masters as Demo/Workshop chairman and Eric Baker as Web master. Both of these positions are critical to the organization's success. If you have the skills to take on the website please contact me. Becky has done a great job to schedule demos for the next 5 months but I believe the ongoing success of the gallery lies in active studio use with workshops and ongoing well attended classes. We are seeking an art/business intern from UOP or Delta to help us with the web and social media

Finally I heard from Larry Palimar, tasting room manager at Woodbridge Winery, that the barrel room is no more, making a Spring Show at the winery impossible. We don't have a chairman for the Spring Show, a big job when we hold it in a location that we have experience with but overwhelming when we have to find a new location, a new way of hanging, finding additional sponsors. I am contemplating what the gallery would be without a Spring Show. We can't do it without a chairman. Unless someone steps up as chairman by the end of November, we will be forced to cancel the 2017 Spring Show. The board will be seeking alternative ways to raise funds needed to keep the gallery open.

## **Small Works show**

Call to artist is out. We limited the Small works show to just one month this year. We will be attaching the full Call to Artist along with this newsletter. Receiving for this show is November 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> noon to 5PM at the gallery. Reception is Friday December 2<sup>nd</sup>, Awards will be given at 7PM. We hope you will participate in the show. As always we need volunteers to help with receiving (Nov 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup>), Judging and for the reception.
