## Submitting Work to the Gallery

This is a reminder that when you bring work into the gallery for a new show you need to do the following:

### 1. Label your work.

- If it is hanging art, you should clearly put a label on the back with your name, the title of the art, the media and the price. Do NOT use post it notes, they fall off and get lost.
- If it is not a hanging piece, you should price each individual piece, with your name or number and price. Stickers are ok but we need to be able to clearly identify the piece. If you don't need a printed label for each piece, you do not need to list each individual item, but you should log them; i.e. 4 cups at \$20, etc. We will try to create individual labels for each item if they are listed individually. This includes cards and prints.

### 2. Place incoming artwork in the bins in the back room.

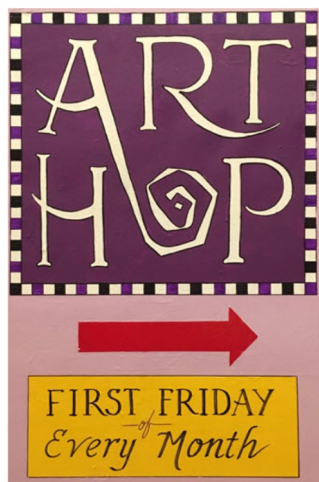
- We don't really want to stack it up in the front of The Gallery. The gallery hanging team is challenged when incoming art is spread around the gallery.
- If you have special hanging instructions, for example if you want the items hung for two months or are not going to be able to pick up your work at the end of the month let Elsa Bates know [Tenorherb@aol.com](mailto:Tenorherb@aol.com). It's best to go directly to The Gallery team.

### 3. Deliver your work on time.

- Our receiving for gallery shows is almost always the last weekend of the month and we hang the show the following Monday or Tuesday. Labels are created right away. It is difficult to find places for work that is delivered after the show has been hung and creates extra work for the volunteer who is creating the labels.

### 4. Bring your calendar, Sign up to sit The Gallery and Pay your hanging fees.

- If you can't sit The Gallery please arrange for another member to fill in. We have a couple of members who will sit The Gallery for \$20. It is possible to make special arrangements if you can't sit one month but maybe can twice the next month. We also will waive hanging fees for people who sign up and sit 3 times a month. Work with us. It's important to have The Gallery open on our regular days.
